Dear Requestor:

The above-referenced firm represents the Town of Addison, Texas ("City"). This letter is intended to further address the above-referenced information request received by the City from you asking for body-worn camera videos.

Please be advised that it has been determined that you have not provided the information as required by Texas law to obtain copies of the body camera footage responsive to your request. Therefore, the City is not required to release the responsive videos to you. A failure to provide all of the information required by Texas law to be part of a request for body camera videos information does not preclude you from making a future request for the same recorded information. If you have requested other information, the remainder of your request will be processed in accordance with the Public Information Act.

Please note that the City staff cannot provide legal advice to a requestor or provide the information needed to properly request a specific body cam video.
