I request the original technical metadata and lab logs from the FBI Photographic Unit regarding the development of the 6th Floor Snipers Nest photographs taken on November 22-23, 1963. Specifically, I am seeking any 'rejected' or 'out-of-focus' exposures that were not included in the Warren Commission Exhibit 877, and any documentation of 'retouching' or 'technical enhancements' performed by the lab before submission to the Commission. I request the original inspection reports and high-resolution macroscopic photographs of the Presidential Limousine windshield (Warren Commission Exhibit 350) taken immediately upon arrival at the White House garage on November 23, 1963. I am specifically requesting any photos showing 'through-and-through' penetrations or 'inner-surface' fracturing that contradict the 'inside-out' lead-deposit theory. I request the 'Daily Activity Logs' and 'Internal Memo Records' of FBI Agents James Bookhout and James Hosty for November 22-24, 1963. I am seeking any 'informal' or 'handwritten' field notes regarding the questioning of Lee Harvey Oswald

that were not formally transcribed into the Commission's reports, and any 'Disposal Certificates' for notes that were allegedly destroyed. I request the Secret Service 'Protective Research' files regarding Officer J.D. Tippit and his association with 'Persons of Interest' in the Dallas area prior to November 22, 1963. Pursuant to 5 U.S.C. § 552(a)(6)(E) and 36 C.F.R. § 1250.28, I am requesting expedited processing of this request. As a representative of the news media and an author primarily engaged in disseminating information to the public via the 'Siege of Liberty' network, I certify that there is an urgent and compelling need to inform the public regarding the following government activities: Integrity of the National Archive: The requested records concern the potential loss, theft, or unauthorized removal of primary forensic evidence (specifically the President's brain and original autopsy films) from federal custody. This is a matter of exceptional media interest and directly affects public confidence in the government's ability to maintain the integrity of its archives. Due Process and State/Federal Conflict: The records regarding federal interference in the State of Louisiana v. Clay Shaw trial address alleged activities by federal agencies to obstruct a state-level criminal prosecution, a matter of significant concern to the public's understanding of the separation of powers. Recent Declassification Mandates: Given the passage of the January 2025 Executive Order and the subsequent rolling releases in early 2026, there is an immediate need for the public to understand the criteria currently being used to withhold 60-year-old records. I certify that the information contained in this request for expedited processing is true and correct to the best of my knowledge and belief.
