Under § 1701.454(a), the confidentiality of an F5 does not apply if the officer was terminated for a violation of the law. As Officer Schieck was disciplined for a firearm violation on a school campus and reckless driving in a school zone, as well

as stalking and road rage—both violations of the Texas Penal and Transportation Codes—the confidentiality protection is waived. I demand the production of the F5 report.

RE: Notice of Inconsistent Production and Violation of § 1701.451

Mr. Metcalf,

Your claim that the Elm Ridge Police Department "does not have a copy of the F5" for Officer Alan Schieck is a legal impossibility.

Under Texas Occupations Code § 1701.451, Chief Kennedy was required to obtain and review Schieck's F5 and F5R before appointing him. If the department does not have this file, then the Chief failed to perform a mandatory ministerial duty required for the legal commissioning of a peace officer in the State of Texas.

Furthermore, your office previously sent an email stating "here is the file," which purposefully omitted the very attachment I requested. This "bait and switch" is a bad-faith obstruction of the TPIA.

I am now giving you a choice:

1. Produce the F5 Attachment: Admit it was "overlooked" and send the digital copy immediately.
2. Maintain the "No File" Claim: If you maintain that the file does not exist, I will immediately forward this admission to TCOLE's Enforcement Division as evidence that Chief Kennedy falsified his L-1 Appointment certification and hired an officer in direct violation of state licensing standards.

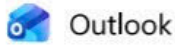
Either you are hiding a "Dishonorable Discharge," or you are admitting your Chief committed an administrative crime to get Schieck on the force. Which is it?

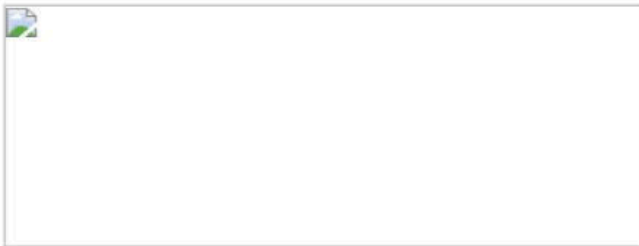

Two things can be true at the same time, which is the case here. The Chief made a request to Addison who uploaded documents to a portal that was available for a limited amount of time. The Chief obtained access to the portal and reviewed the information. The Chief did not download or store the information. The PD no longer has access to the portal because it was only available for a limited amount of time. So, again, the PD cannot produce the F5 because it does not maintain a physical copy. It was only viewed by the Chief through the time-limited portal.

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
