Mr. Metcalf,

I am in receipt of your cost estimate dated April 13, 2026, regarding my request for records pertaining to Officer Alan Schieck.

I hereby officially accept the estimated charges of \$180.00. However, it is noted that while your office was remarkably diligent in citing §552.261 and §552.263 of the Texas Government Code to justify a \$180.00 "bond," you failed to provide a functional avenue to actually transmit these funds.

Under the Texas Public Information Act, the goal is transparency, not a "shell game" where the citizen is handed a bill and then left to guess how to pay it while a 10-day "withdrawal" clock runs in the background. Your letter provides mailing addresses and fax numbers for "responses," but notably lacks:

1. **A secure online payment portal link.**
2. **Instruction on whom to make a check or money order payable to.**
3. **Confirmation if personal delivery of funds is accepted at the Savannah Boulevard location.**

It is deeply concerning that a department with "more than fifteen full-time employees" and a retained law firm lacks the basic administrative infrastructure to accept a digital payment in 2026.

My Demands:

1. **Stop the Clock:** Since I have officially accepted the charges via this email, the 10-day withdrawal window must be tolled until you provide a clear, immediate method for payment.
2. **Payment Instructions:** Provide the exact name of the entity for a cashier's check and confirm if it can be hand-delivered today to ensure no further "administrative delays" occur.

I find it "disturbing"—to use the Chief's vocabulary—that the department is hyper-efficient at processing 30% collection fees and bi-weekly warrant runs, yet becomes functionally illiterate when a citizen tries to pay for records concerning a high-liability officer with a history of school-zone endangerment and insubordination.

I expect the payment instructions by the close of business today.

Mr. Metcalf,

Your latest correspondence is perhaps the most vivid illustration of the "Signal vs. Noise" problem I have encountered to date. While you spent several paragraphs attempting to "polish a turd" of a response with condescending lectures on business days and email etiquette, you confirmed exactly what I suspected: your department operates on a "caveman" administrative model designed to obstruct, not assist, the public.

1. The Payment Barrier In 2026, claiming that a municipal entity "does not accept" cash or credit/debit cards is an admission of either total incompetence or a deliberate attempt to create a "shell game." Requiring a citizen to travel to a Walmart to get a money order because you lack the drive to implement a basic digital payment portal is a waste of public time and resources.

2. The "Weekend" Defense You call it "ironic" that I expect a response on a weekend. I call it a reality check. Criminals do not take the weekend off. The "booger-throwing" road-rager you just hired, Officer Schieck, didn't limit his 63-mph school zone stunt or his insubordinate pursuits to "business hours." Your insistence on a 9-to-5 mentality while representing a public safety agency proves you are fundamentally out of touch with the gravity of the situation.

3. Professional Standard Violations Your tone is rude, nasty, and deeply insecure. You are acting exactly like the officer you are so desperate to protect: raging, out of control, and hiding behind a badge (or in your case, a bar card). You belong at the DMV, not representing a town's legal interests. I am sending this entire exchange to the Town Council so they can see exactly how their "General Counsel" treats the citizens he is paid to serve. I doubt they would approve of your "meanest and nastiest" approach to public service.

4. The "I Don't Want to Know" Culture When I walked into the station to report a crime, your Sergeant told me, "I don't want to know." Now, you are doing the same thing—ignoring the documented "Signal" of Schieck's termination for insubordination and performance deficiencies just so you can win a technical argument about TPIA deadlines. You aren't "representing" the city; you are exposing it to massive liability.

Notice of Delivery: I will be at the Elm Ridge WCID office today with your money order. I'll enjoy the trip to Walmart, as it serves as a reminder of how much more efficient the private sector is compared to your stagnant office. Since your department "loses" prisoner wallets and millions go "missing" in Addison, I will be requiring a timestamped, signed receipt for this "bond." I imagine my \$180 won't last the day before it's swallowed by the same "noise" that hides the rest of your accounting.

Go take the rest of the day off, Christopher. Think about what you are doing. You are the only thing standing between a corrupt officer and the public right now, and you're doing a terrible job of it.

P.S.

Your "caveman" administrative policies have now officially crossed from local incompetence into a violation of federal law.

You stated in your last email that the Elm Ridge Police Department and WCID **"does not accept payment by cash."** This policy is a direct violation of **31 U.S.C. § 5103**, which mandates that United States currency is legal tender for **all debts, public charges, taxes, and dues**. A Public Information Act fee is, by definition, a "public charge." By issuing an official cost estimate and then refusing to accept the national currency of the United States to satisfy that charge, you are engaging in an illegal obstruction of the monetary system to prevent the disclosure of public records.

The "Schieck Shield" has become a Federal Issue: It is clear that you are so terrified of the "Signal" contained in Officer Schieck's disciplinary file—the school zone endangerment, the insubordination, and the systemic racial profiling—that you are willing to break federal law to keep it hidden. You are attempting to force me into a third-party commercial transaction (a money order) because you lack the integrity to accept the very cash your own salaries are paid with.

Mr. Metcalf,

I am in receipt of your demand for a physical mailing address to produce paper copies of the requested records. I am formally rejecting this "requirement" based on the following:

- 1. Violation of Tex. Gov't Code § 552.228:** I have explicitly requested **digital production** via email. As your office and the PD are currently communicating with me via electronic mail, you have the "technological ability" to provide the records in the medium requested. Under Texas law, you are required to provide the information in the requested electronic medium to ensure the most efficient use of public resources.
- 2. State-Created Danger & Requestor Safety:** As documented in the very archives I am requesting, Officer Alan Schieck has a "consistent pattern" of stalking and harassment—specifically targeting me. Your demand that I provide a physical home address to be entered into a departmental database accessible by Officer Schieck is a deliberate act of endangerment.
- 3. Breach of Administrative Segregation:** It has already been evidenced that TPIA requests are not being handled by a segregated records department, as the Chief of Police has already interjected himself into a "fact-finding" process regarding my private requests. I will not provide my physical location to an agency that is clearly using the open records process for internal surveillance of a victim of one of its officers.

Because Addison terminated him for "off-duty encounters" and "concerning behavior," and because I have a history of him stalking me, the city is now on "**Actual Notice**" of a physical threat.

Final Notice: I have tendered the \$180.00 "bond." Your 10-day production window is closing. If you do not produce the records **digitally**—as is my right under § 552.228—I will immediately file a formal complaint with the **Office of the Attorney General** for both **Overcharging** (by forcing unnecessary paper/postage costs) and **Refusal of Access**.

I will be accepting the records at ryanjohnsonthepatriot@gmail.com. No physical address is required, and none will be provided.

PS - This am, 12/31/2024, I received a notification on my phone of an unauthorized Apple Air Tag that was tracking me, I took my vehicle to the City of Dallas Police Department North District, where Officer Mays took my information and looked over my vehicle, he did not find anything. I am mentioning this at this time, as I am unsure if this is related to any of these incidents and want to include all previous and (possibly new) information.

I REFUSE to live in the fear, terror and anxiety that your Rogue off duty officer is comfortable in projecting on the citizens of Dallas anytime he chooses as then travels back to Lewisville, like nothing ever happened. Meanwhile rendering ill, low level, unprofessional, unbecoming behavior, as he appears to be extremely comfortable in emulating and will unleash terror, wrongdoing, fear, to anyone, in a disgusting display of power, that exposes the Public to experiences and behavior that are greater aligned with a Criminal Enterprise versus sworn officers, who took oaths, to protect and serve the same citizens that they are harming.

Spewing hate/racism/sexism and wreaking terror and intimidation on a African American (woman) Dallas Resident because he was upset about what he determined was a traffic offense, should not be an option when an off duty officer is traveling through multiple cities. Further, when that approach/position is taken, he should not ignore requests to contact the Authorities for the proper city's jurisdiction and instead flee the scene before they arrive.

1st Incident - September 18, 2024

Driving my White Mustang Convertible 5.0, heading home from work down Addison Road (N) - a motorcycle vessel turned out into traffic, almost causing an accident, as he was driving slower than the traffic he turned in front of, I went around him, and proceeded home. Turning left on Trinity Mills, into the right lane, the motorcycle vessel sped up and went around me, he turned right at the light (Voss road) I turned right behind him as well (this is my daily route home as it is the only street available to access my home). He began to slowly travel up the middle of the street, far less than the 30mph speed limit. The street turns from 1 open/wide lane, to 2 lanes, with obvious broken lines, indicating that the 2 cars are expected to travel, individually, in their respective lanes. He continued to slowly travel down the middle of the street, now driving in both lanes. I drove behind him for a moment, After stopping and proceeding through the stop sign, I accelerated and went around him. I arrived in the right lane, with 2 cars in front of me, and about 4 cars in the 2nd lane next to me (left turn lane). The light was red, I had a bad feeling about this guy and leaned over to get my phone out, just in case.

Before I could even open it up, there he was! At my window, banging on it, yelling, and screaming!! Windows are tinted and I rolled it down, he continued to yell and scream, "YOU CAN'T FUCKING DRIVE!!! LEARN HOW TO FUCKING DRIVE WITH YOUR STUPID ASS!!! He continued this rant and I told him to get the hell away from me and my car and how dare you have the audacity to get off your vessel, in the middle of traffic, and approach someone yelling and screaming because you don't like their driving!! He then yelled " I'M A OFF-DUTY POLICE OFFICER AND I'LL DO WHAT THE FUCK I

WANT TO DO"! I said, "I don't care who the hell you are, unless you're about to identify yourself as an on-duty Dallas police officer, with a badge and badge number and you're issuing me a citation for a broken law, then get the hell away from me and my damn car! This is your fault in the first front as you have been ignoring traffic laws since we were riding down Addison Rd and you turned in front of oncoming traffic, then back there you were riding up the middle of a two lane street, taking up both lanes so you might want to learn to drive and get the hell away from me and my car"! He was LIVID!! He began shouting "FUCK YOU!! YOU BITCH FUCK YOU BLACK BITCH"! At that time I exited my vehicle, with phone in hand and said "I'm calling the police right now, since you are the police, they definitely need to know about your disgusting, vile, disrespectful, sexist, racist behavior that you are out here spewing because you don't like someone's driving. (ROAD RAGE) He continued to yell and curse, but began quickly retreating back to his vessel when he saw me calling the police.

Description of Conduct and/or performance giving rise to the proposed discipline:

During an off-duty encounter, you displayed concerning behavior, which has led to my loss of confidence in your ability to represent the Addison Police Department effectively. During the incident, you escalated the confrontation by engaging the other motorist in the roadway, using profanity, and identifying yourself as a police officer in a manner that was unprofessional and unbecoming. Your actions reflect a sustained pattern of poor judgment and conduct that brings discredit to the department. As a police officer with your tenure, I expect more of you. There was no reason to engage in this behavior, and your actions only served to exacerbate the encounter. Outside of this incident, you have previously demonstrated poor judgment and an inability to de-escalate properly:

- In 2018, you were involved in an incident where you used invidious language while engaging in an argumentative discussion during a traffic stop and failed to de-escalate properly.
In 2020, you were involved in an incident where you were yelling at an intoxicated suspect after he pointed his finger at you, an action that was inappropriate and could have escalated the incident.
In 2020, you were involved in an incident where you received a 1-day suspension for your decision to engage in reckless driving during the pursuit of a burglary suspect.
In 2021, you were involved in an incident where you lost a prisoner's property.
In 2022, you were involved in an incident where you drove 63mph in a school zone, on the wrong side of the road to catch up with a speeding motorist.

In 2024, you failed to properly document an incident of family violence, as required by the Texas Code of Criminal Procedure.

Reason for Discipline:

The employee's termination is the result of a sustained and extensive disciplinary history, demonstrating a consistent pattern of performance deficiencies and conduct violations. Despite multiple corrective actions, including verbal coaching, written coaching, reprimands, and a suspension, the employee has not demonstrated sustained improvement. Recent violations, including failure to submit a required Family Violence Report (in violation of CCP 3.05), negligent discharge of a weapon, and repeated issues with professionalism and documentation, highlight ongoing concerns with judgment, policy compliance, and officer accountability. The current violations fall under Department Policies 320.5.8 (Performance) and 320.5.9 (Conduct subsections e., f., h., and m.), and cumulatively warrant termination due to failure to meet the standards of conduct expected of personnel and the risk posed to public trust and department integrity.

During an off-duty encounter, you displayed concerning behavior, which has led to my loss of confidence in your ability to represent the Addison Police Department effectively. Outside of this incident, you have previously demonstrated poor judgment and an inability to deescalate properly.

The employee's termination is the result of a sustained and extensive disciplinary history, demonstrating a consistent pattern of performance deficiencies and conduct violations. Despite multiple corrective actions, including verbal coaching,

written coaching, reprimands, and a suspension, the employee has not demonstrated sustained improvement.

But you gave him a raise and a promotion.

He is unmanageable and refuses to follow orders to terminate a pursuit, leading to a crash.

Shortly after this radio transmission, the suspect began traveling northbound in the southbound lanes at 13000 Preston Rd. and Officer Diaz informed dispatch. All three officers continued their pursuit. Officer Diaz continued to give information over the radio about the vehicle traveling on the wrong side of the road, then later said they were on the right side of the road when Air One asked, quickly followed by being on the wrong side. After this information was relayed, Sgt. Helton informed them to "back off" (terminate) to prevent any accidents or injuries. Officer Murray immediately slowed down and turned off his lights and sirens. Officers Diaz and Schieck slowed down but continued with their lights and siren activated.

Sgt. Helton believed that the pursuit was terminated after he informed them to back off. Once Sgt. Helton determined that they were still in pursuit based on Officers Schieck and Diaz radio transmissions, he stated to terminate the chase. Officers Schieck and Diaz then turned off their emergency equipment. No other officers were involved in the pursuit.

As the officers were enroute back to the city, Air One located the vehicle at 5891 Arapaho parked and abandoned in the apartment complex. Officers Schieck and Williams went to the scene and towed the vehicle back to the station sallyport. Crime Scene Officer Sanger processed the vehicle at the station with consent from the registered owner.
