To the Officer for Public Information:

Under the Texas Public Information Act, I request a copy of the following administrative records regarding the **processing and cost estimation** for my requests **Reference No: 3083CAM-040826RJ** (Ryan Johnson) regarding the personnel files and internal affairs records of **Officer Allen Schieck**:

1. **The Itemized Labor Log:** All internal records, time-sheets, or 'GovQA/WebQA' staff notes used to calculate the '10-hour' labor estimate provided for this request.
2. **The Metadata of the Estimate:** The automated 'History' or 'Audit Log' from the Town's records management portal showing the exact date and time the 10-hour estimate was created and the identity of the staff member who authorized it.
3. **Cross-Agency Coordination:** All emails or internal messages between the City Secretary's Office, the Police Department, and the City Attorney's Office (specifically referencing 'Ryan Johnson' or 'Schieck') discussing the decision to require a cost deposit or the calculation of labor hours.
4. **Standard Operating Procedures for Fee Estimates:** A copy of the Town's internal policy for calculating labor hours for digital records, and a list of all TPIA requests in the last 12 months where a '10-hour' labor estimate was issued, to determine if this is a standard template for delay.
5. **Certification of Search:** Documentation certifying whether the search for digital records (emails/texts) included personal devices used for official business per **Tex. Gov't Code § 552.233**, and the specific keywords used to conclude that '10 hours' of labor was necessary for compilation.
