Good Day,

I am reaching out today to discuss the below request. Not understanding how IA is not able to locate an off-duty police officer when they have the license plate number of his motorcycle and the motorcycle club name. This evening, while driving home from work, I encountered the exact same vessel and individual. Due to your inability to locate this individual and this task being placed on me as a citizen, I stayed with him until he once again, approached my vehicle and began aggressively yelling "do you live in this neighborhood" I did not respond and instead remain calm, he felt comfortable in this area (Castle Hills Lewisville) and felt that I would be arrested so he eagerly called the Lewisville police, and disclosed himself as an "off duty Lewisville Police Officer". He patiently waited and unlike him, in the Dallas incident, I did too and didn't flee the scene and equally called them. Got connected with a Lewisville Police Dispatcher, where I explained the situation and advised that I was seeking a recorded, registered interaction so that there will be a record of this incident in which I will be able to refer to and provide the incident number to IA so that they can investigate his repulsive racist, sexist, unhinged behavior that he egregiously displayed when he harassed and assaulted me on this day, right down the street from my home. She stayed on the line with me and assured me that the officer coming would be understanding of the situation and will surely resolve appropriately. The officer arrived and I explained the back story, and read/showed him this email. He confirmed that he had his body cam on as well, he walked away for a little bit and came back with a pamphlet that had his name, badge # and incident # to reference. When I asked for the off duty officer suspect name, he advised this will be available and searchable in public records. He then advised me to "watch the news tonight bc the LPD will be featured, for their ill behavior" as it appears that this and like disgusting type of behavior runs rampant! He asked me "what do you want me to tell him" (he realized the severity and due to the current investigations, he did not divulge that it was me in the car) initially, I said "I don't care bc he had to be identified" but to play along, in the moment, so I could ensure my safety of leaving the scene of being surrounded by LPD, I simply stated "tell him this was a case of mistaken identity and I deeply apologize for the inconvenience" . The officer nodded and I left, while 2 LPD officers and the off-duty officer/suspect stayed behind talking. This leads me to my issue, I am an African American City of Dallas resident, who was minutes from my home, from work, where this same off duty officer/suspect, after the attack, fled the scene, and is now STALKING my area! Is he looking to for me? Is he going to attack me? Is he going to retaliate against me? This dude is completely unhinged!! There is no way, after he did that, he should even feel comfortable to "return to the scene of the crime" on Voss and Frankford in Dallas especially when he lives in Castle Hills in Lewisville! His disgusting behavior is the norm for him and I'm pretty sure that he antagonizes Dallas citizens, daily/regularly with his arrogant, entitled, RACIST, behavior as he rides though the city, because he doesn't even live in the city!! At this time, it is IMPERATIVE that he be prosecuted to the fullest extent of the law that he SWORE to uphold and protect! I am scared! I want protection! This off duty suspect should not be allowed ANYWHERE near me or my home! I want a Restraining Order issued against him immediately!! I REFUSE to live in fear due to this situation that had someone in your office cared a little more, could have ran

the license plate of the individual, saw his name, researched the Iron Circle Texas Motorcycle Club, located this off duty officer/suspect! In doing this, he would have been "outed" and I would have applied for the Restraining Order at that time and today's incident would have never happened!!!! This off duty officer/suspect needs to be stopped immediately!!! No way an "officer", displaying this level of negative emotional and mental instability, should be allowed ANYWHERE near a badge and in NO WAY should he hold a title where his core responsibility is "To Protect and Serve" the very citizens he is CHOOSING to attack, at any moment, bc he is unable to control his emotions and instead having racist, sexist meltdowns with random women, in another city, where he is touting and hiding behind his badge, while using it and himself as a scare tactic to intimidate and deliver his OWN justice as he delusionally feels that these are HIS streets and he will ACCOST, APPROACH, HARASS, STALK, CURSE, YELL, SCREAM, THREATEN, HOLLER RACIST/SEXIST EPITHETS, and RENDER his FURY at ANY give time, on ANY given day, in ANY city and will flee, run, leave, hide, disappear back to his Suburban city where the department is COMPROMISED when it's time for his behavior to be addressed but has proven when in his own area, miles away, in the COMPROMISED police department where he and his buddies do this to citizens so much, that the entire DEPARTMENT is facing negative light and scrutiny, he will wait, stay, and play victim!!! Today, he also hit my car with his motorcycle helmet, this too was reported during the call.

The date of the incident is 11/13/2024 with complaint number 2400-91669 and Officer Merchant #763 is the officer who professionally handled this interaction as he understood his assignment of protecting me from his fellow officer while his own department is being negatively impacted by fellow officers inappropriate, unacceptable behavior. The report should reflect the name of the caller/suspect/off duty officer who accosted me on September 18, 2024 along with all of his identifying information that you requested from me in this email.

We are living in perilous times and MUST fight back to stand, in uniformity, that this behavior is unacceptable and will NOT be tolerated, at least not here in Dallas! His behavior is a disrespectful slap in the face to the citizens and the Dallas Police Department as he has no regard for either! As of today, the LPD is under active IA investigation and in the past week, has FIRED multiple officers for inappropriate behavior! This department is obviously COMPROMISED and needs a full investigation to ENSURE that the public is safe from what is appearing to look like "criminal with badges" and "crooked cops"!!! It is DETRIMENTAL to rid these cancers from police departments as again, this is a disservice to both citizens and the Honest officers who serve! I will equally be filing a complaint with the LPD as well! This incident has left me always watching over my shoulder, triggered and overall afraid, which is how I recognized him! I have attached the photo initially taken from September's incident in Dallas and additional photos, taken yesterday. Social Responsibility requires you to investigate, research, and do your due diligence to get to the bottom of this matter and reprimand this Racist, Sexist, unhinged off-duty officer suspect before he hurts or even worse kills someone with the blatant hatred that he has in his heart while collecting taxpayers dollars and hiding behind the badge of a police department that is currently experiencing disgrace due to investigations that led to a major shake up!! Keep shaking and be prepared for more Bad Apples to fall from that tree!



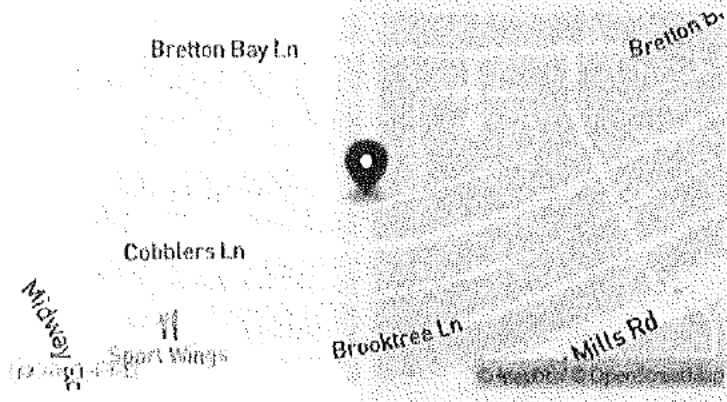

**Incident Description**

On 9/18/2024, I was traveling east on Trinity Mills Road heading toward Voss Road - there was a motorcycle vessel behind me, tailing me hard, he went around me and then turned right onto Voss Road - this is my route home and I turned at Voss as well. The street, when you first turn, is 1 lane going in each direction, around the 3rd block in, the street divides into 2 lanes, in each direction, with lane markings on the road. Speed limit is 30, the motorcycle vessel is going about 18mph and is traveling up the middle of the street - when the lanes break open to 2 separate lanes, he is now straddling both lanes, riding up the middle of the both, I attempted to get to the right lane, he moved over to that lane, I then attempted to get into the left lane, he moved over to that lane - still traveling over 10 miles under the speed limit - at this point he is impeding traffic - I did not want to engage in an incident, so I went around him and proceeded down Voss Road. The light at Frankford was red, there were cars in both lanes, I was in the right lane, behind another car, the motorcycle vessel approached behind me, he attempted to squeeze/split between the 2 lanes but the street is narrow and he was unable to do so, causing him to have to sit behind me. I saw him in my rearview mirror taking photos of my license plate, I grabbed my phone and in an instant, this large white guy, on a motorcycle vessel wearing a motorcycle vest is now off of his vessel, in between lanes and is at my window ranting and raving about how I can't drive - I immediately got my phone and put it up, he is now cursing and yelling again that I need to learn how to drive, I loudly advised him to get away from my car - other drivers began rolling up their windows as he was extremely irate! He then reached in his jacket and pulled out a badge, still yelling, screaming and cursing. I asked if he was an actual officer as he was in plain clothes and personal motorcycle vessel. He continued to yell and scream and advised him again that his behavior was scary and that if he is not citing me, he should not be approaching my vehicle, and no way yelling and screaming at me as that is Road Rage - he then began yelling calling me "BITCH" and walking away - I exited my vehicle, to get his license plate number and advised him I was calling the police. I asked for him to show me his badge again, he refused, I took a photo of the back of his motorcycle vessel and noticed both his motorcycle jacket and emblem on his motorcycle vessel read "IRON CIRCLE TEXAS" - he began cursing at me again to "GET THE FUCK BACK IN THE CAR". I refused and told him again that I was calling the police to report him and his behavior and if he is the police, call them to this incident. Also asked for his badge number again. I stated ok, "I see your

affiliation name so it will be easy to locate you" He then began trying to exit the area, he almost hit another car trying to get away quickly as he knew the police was coming. He fled and turned right down Frankford Road. After reporting the incident to the 911 operator, I went online to research the affiliation, it was then I learned that he IS a police officer!!! Once I learned that he actually is an officer as this "MC" is only for law enforcement, I knew that no matter what it took, I had to get this info/data over to the the people who can research, address and monitor this individual for the future because this is so scary!!! I am a single black woman, being accosted by an off duty police officer who is using his badge as an intimidation factor and he has captured my license plate number and now knows where I live!! The 911 operator, even though she was given the license plate number, stated, "there is nothing I can do" - I researched and located info to contact Office of Police Oversight, where I called last night, voice mail was full - called back this am, spoke to Officer Soto, explained the whole incident, he apologized on behalf of the officer and told me there was nothing he could do but to contact the Internal affairs department. I called there this am and spoke to P. Williams, who then told me that I had to send an email and that it could take up to 3 weeks before I hear back!! I explained to her that this is a very scary type of situation and in 2024 when a Police officer does this type of unhinged behavior in the middle of the day, in front of everyone, then runs before he can be held accountable, this is a dangerous and he is a threat to the community that he is supposed to be protecting! He appears to be very comfortable acting this way, meaning this is his norm! I am very concerned about my safety and the safety of other residents, especially women, who travel daily, as if he does not like your driving, although he is an officer his way of handling it is to harass, intimidate and subject others to his unhinged road rage. This could have ended much worse as he, a stranger, not in police uniform, not in a police vessel, approaching someone's vehicle in a hostile manner, yelling, screaming, cursing and reaching into his jacket....please take this seriously and address this rogue officer sooner, while you can, rather than later, when he does this again...

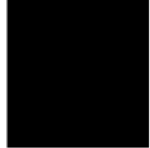
